

## PCC COMMENTS ON THAMES VALLEY POLICE CUSTODY INSPECTION (HMIC)

On 1 July 2014, I reviewed how the Force had progressed with its custody improvement plan - the plan was a key recommendation from HMI's Joint Inspectorate.

I am pleased that the key areas – particularly in health care provision - are being addressed in an appropriate and effective manner.

72% of all recommendations in the overall improvement plan are now 'green risk rated' (completed), with the majority of remaining 'amber risks' due to be signed-off over the summer of 2014.

I am confident that the Chief Constable is fully on track to deliver the necessary changes, and that a future repeat inspection from the Inspectorate will see enhanced improvements in the care of detainees in Thames Valley Police's custody.
